

Bonded Retainers

Secure your patient's smile

Bonded retainers are a valuable way to ensure secure post-treatment orthodontic positions of the front teeth, particularly in adult orthodontic treatment. The custom-made retainer is bonded to the back of the front teeth to maintain their new position.

S4S can also provide a Bonded Retainer with Jig - designed to save the clinician significant time when placing the wire in a patient's mouth. The jig simply clicks into place, holding the wire in situ 'hands-free' whilst the wire is bonded in place with dental composite.

Construction requirements

- Alginate impression of the arch requiring the retainer

Bonded Retainers are very common. Most adults undertaking orthodontic treatment may require permanent retention following the removal of their brackets and archwires. Fixed retainers are made in our orthodontic department by skilled technicians.

Rationale

- Post-orthodontic treatment retention
- Popular for adult patients
- Stabilises mobile teeth
- Reduces relapse of heavily rotated teeth
